### **Charles S. (Tyler) Przybylek, J.D., Joins Pro2Serve Board of Directors**

Dr. Van Hook is the former President of Lockheed Martin Energy Systems (LMES). In that role he guided operations of the Oak Ridge Y-12 Plant for DOE. Prior to joining LMES, Dr. Van Hook served as Executive Vice President of Lockheed Martin Energy Research Corporation. During his 30 years at Oak Ridge National Laboratory (ORNL) he served as Deputy Director, Director of the Environmental Sciences Division, Director of the Center for Global Environmental Studies and as a research ecologist.

Dr. Barry Goss is Pro2Serve's founder, President, and Chairman of the Board. He has more than 30 years of experience providing professional technical and business services to government and private industry. Prior to founding Pro2Serve, he lead two other very successful professional services business units at Battelle Memorial Institute and Science Applications International Corporation.
