Pro2Serve on Team to Design New NNSA National Security Campus

Oak Ridge, Tennessee, August 12, 2009 - Pro2Serve Professional Project Services, Inc. (Pro2Serve®) has been awarded a contract for mechanical, electrical, piping (MEP), security and selected architectural design for the new \$500 million National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) National Security Campus in Kansas City, MO.

As part of the CenterPoint Zimmer/HNTB design team, Pro2Serve will be responsible for the MEP design and consulting on 1.2 million square feet of manufacturing, laboratory, and processing buildings as well as the security design for the entire campus and buildings for the NNSA and the U.S. General Services Administration. Rear Admiral (ret.) Ray Alexander, Pro2Serve's Senior Vice President of Engineering, stated that "The execution of NNSA's vital strategic mission will be enhanced by the new plant which will provide manufacturing, laboratory, office and warehouse space. We are extremely pleased to contribute to this national security asset."

The new facility, employing approximately 2,100 workers, will be built to LEED Gold certification standards. The initial LEED scorecard includes innovative irrigation systems for water efficiency, increased energy efficiency, better life-cycle costing, green power and external internal lighting shelves to maximize the use of natural light and reduce glare to insure daylight effectiveness.

The project began with rezoning and replatting in April 2009, and is scheduled to open in September 2011.
