

Pro2Serve Announces Executive Promotions

The Board of Directors of Professional Project Services, Inc. (Pro2Serve[®]), has announced several executive promotions to become effective January 1, the beginning of the Company's fiscal year 2010.

Dr. L. Kirk Ellard, current Assistant Vice President for Pro2Serve's Security Programs at Los Alamos National Laboratory, will assume the role of Vice President and Senior Program Manager for Pro2Serve's Integrated Physical Security Solutions Division, with responsibility for ensuring program performance across the Division's numerous physical security contracts. Mr. Ellard has more than 30 years experience in engineering, project management, and national security. He had responsible charge for \$1.4B of construction for DOE and DoD projects, including a \$400M international collaboration with Russia.
